Using historic maps from the University of Sheffield map collection this exhibition examines stories of change within the city. It looks at Western Bank and the development of the University; the lost music halls and theatres of 'Little Piccadilly'; the training of soldiers in the First World War; and public houses and social class in different areas of Sheffield.

The exhibition also offers visitors the opportunity to make their own unique contribution and put themselves on the map in Sheffield.
