Registration

Step 1: Obtain a letter confirming your honorary status with the University of Sheffield.

Do this by emailing your CV to Ruth Lilley, Staffing Officer: r.e.lilley@sheffield.ac.uk. Staff working in the Associate Teaching Hospitals will also need to send a supporting letter from their Associate Director of Teaching or Medical Director to confirm involvement in undergraduate teaching.

Step 2: Register with CiCS, the University's IT Dept.

Request an account for the University's network, a MUSE account and an Associate uCard from CiCS. You may do this in person, by post or by email. You must provide CiCS with a copy of the letter confirming your status, a passport style photograph of yourself and a return address. If you are registering in person please telephone first to ensure your details are present on the University's HR database.

Step 3: Activate the uCard in one of the Health Sciences Libraries or by emailing the number on the barcode to v.grant@sheffield.ac.uk.
